



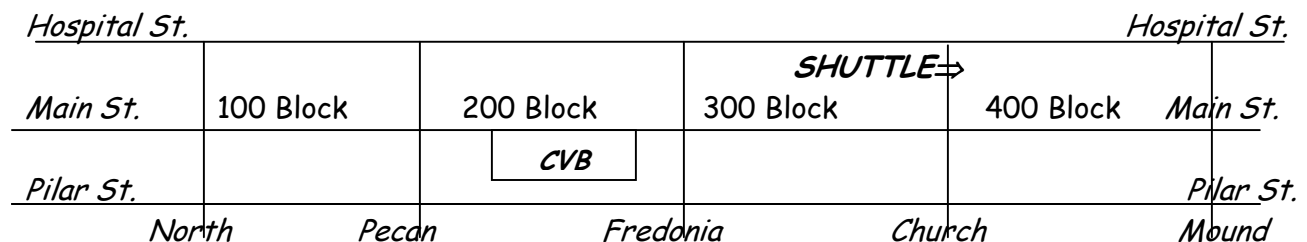
SHOP Downtown during the Blueberry Festival!
