Groovin' blues at the Texas Blueberry Festival

NACOGDOCHES - The 18th annual Texas Blueberry Festival on Saturday, June 9 will feature three separate stages showcasing more than 20 different acts of live entertainment. From 8 a.m. through 4 p.m. performers will provide a full day of noteworthy fun.

From the Plaza Principal Stage, located at Pilar and Pecan Streets on the south end of the town square, expect to hear the strumming sounds of folk, gospel, country and Americana. A little bit of blues may sneak in, too.

Bands and entertainers performing on the Plaza Principal stage will include Jon Hall and John Howard; The Anderson Family Band; Kasey Lansdale; Willie Edwards and the Johnny Ringo Cowboys; trio Cindy Grayson, Kat Tree and Stan King; Katie Rae Davis; and The Hipshakers.

An eclectic group of talent will perform on the Main Street Stage, located at the corner of Mound and Main Streets. Americana singer J.P. Calloway will kick off the morning, followed by Bo Miller and Mike Floyd of the Ozmen Brothers, the band Fire, Nautical Twilight, Joel Calloway and nine-year-old singer and performer Ally Fuller.

Mosey down to Festival Park, just south of downtown, during the morning hours and find a stage offering a twirling presentation, a Taekwondo demonstration and a Rhythm Rockers clogging production.

The Nacogdoches High School Band performs at 10:40 a.m. in Festival Plaza. Band members and director enjoy performing publicly as they continue to prepare for participation in The Rose Parade in January 2008. At 12:40 p.m., the stage transforms to a rocking showplace for bands Dragstrip All Stars (formerly El Kabong) and Los Gallos, a rocking Tex-Mex group.
